Detention Officer	A Detention Officer at Good Guard Security manages the custody and care of detainees in federal detention centers. They maintain order, oversee detainee activities, and ensure compliance with federal detention standards, playing a crucial role in upholding security and human rights within these facilities. The Detention Officer's responsibilities include safeguarding, securing, and escorting violators of immigration laws, exercising surveillance over detainees, and maintaining order and discipline. They attend to the sheltering, feeding, and physical well-being of detainees, provide counseling on personal matters, and supervise detainees during deportation or exclusion hearings. Additionally, they identify potentially hazardous health, safety, security, or discipline issues, oversee voluntary work details, and encourage participation in organized recreational activities. Court Security Officer	A Court Security Officer at Good Guard Security specializes in safeguarding federal courthouses and ensuring the safety of judges, jurors, and court personnel. They are well-versed in legal procedures and trained to handle courtroom disturbances with professionalism and discretion. This position involves patrolling the courthouse to provide security, escorting defendants to and from the courtroom, standing guard during court proceedings, and checking the courtroom for security. Responsibilities include monitoring court entrances and addressing the specific needs of the court system, especially in personal protection for judges, jurors, witnesses, attorneys, and other court participants, including the general public. The role requires specialized training in protecting security areas, maintaining physical fitness, and demonstrating proficiency with firearms or other special weapons. The Armed Security Officer enforces regulations and procedures to prevent security breaches, exercises sound judgment and discretion in incident response, and determines the appropriate course of action, whether that involves direct intervention, requesting assistance, maintaining control or surveillance, or reporting to the appropriate authority. This position requires specialized training in methods and techniques for protecting controlled areas, proficiency with firearms and special weapons, and adherence to rigorous physical fitness standards. Guard I (Unarmed Security)	An Unarmed Security Officer at Good Guard Security is highly trained to maintain safety and order in federal facilities without the use of firearms. Following detailed instructions and procedures, they promptly identify and report emergencies and security violations to the appropriate authorities. While their primary duty is to observe and report, they may intervene directly in situations requiring minimal action to protect property or individuals.
